The employment process will include a written examination, physical agility test, background investigation, oral interview, drug screening, physical examination and psychological examination and may be subject to a polygraph test.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS TO APPLY:

- Once hired, he/she must reside within a 45-minutes response time
- Educational requirements are: High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Must be able to read and write the English language and be licensed or eligible for licensing by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) prior to hiring.
- Favorable background and work history preferred.
- Must be a U.S Citizen and have a valid Texas Driver's License and satisfactory driving record
