- Plea by email: clerkofcourt@uvaldetx.gov
- Pay online anytime at trafficpayment.com, or by calling (during normal business hours) 1-800-444-1187.
- Payments made by mail must be by check, money order, or cashier's check, made payable to City of Uvalde. Do not send cash by mail.

You may request a reset to a future court date by contacting the court at 830-278-8357 and by email clerkofcourt@uvaldetx.gov.

You may contact the Deputy City Attorney at cityattorney@uvaldetx.gov.

Keep in mind:

The Court Clerk may accept for processing the following cases by mail and email, and, after all conditions are met, provide the case to the judge for dismissal with no need to appear:

Expired Texas Driver's License

Conditions: The Defendant produces the temporary license issued by the Department of Public Safety indicating renewal of the license and the date renewed, and the Defendant pays the Court an administration fee of \$20.

Expired Vehicle Registration

Conditions: The Defendant produces the registration receipt form generated by the County Tax Assessor's office and the Defendant pays the Court an administration fee of \$20.

Failure to Maintain Financial Responsibility

Conditions: The Defendant produces proof of insurance, the Court Clerk will call the insurance company and verify the insurance as valid on some of the cases presented for compliance dismissal and there is no administration fee.
