



ADDENDUM NO. 2 TO MAYORAL DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

Pursuant to the emergency declaration issued by the Mayor of the City of Uvalde on 20 March 2020 and continued by resolution of the city council on 24 March 2020, the following additional provisions are declared to be in effect:

1. The City of Uvalde and Uvalde County have jointly appointed a local health authority under Chapter 121 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, Dr. Jared Reading. In addition to the reporting required by federal and state health authorities, all medical providers testing or treating potential COVID-19 patients in Uvalde shall, now and for the duration of the health emergency, immediately report all tests ordered, results obtained, and patient status to the local health authority.
2. Provision 1 from the first addendum (23 March) to the declaration has changed. Customers are still not allowed to congregate around the entrances to grocery stores and other places of business in Uvalde, but the rule to wait in vehicles in the parking lot is rescinded. However, customers shall comply with any and all social distancing rules established by the business.
