

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-21

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, GENERAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY FOR SUCH FISCAL YEAR AS REFLECTED IN SAID BUDGET; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND CONTAINING CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Manager presented the proposed budget of the City of Uvalde for the fiscal year 2014-2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held, after notice as required by law, public hearing on such budget on July 8, 2014, July 22, 2014 and September 9, 2014 at the Regular City Council Meeting, at which hearings all citizens and taxpayers of the City had the right to be present and to be heard and those who requested to be heard were heard;

WHEREAS, this proposed budget will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the Budget is attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes and the City Council desires to adopt the same; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 102 of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council hereby approves and adopts the Budget attached hereto and made a part hereof, a copy of same being on file with the City Secretary. The City Council hereby approves the property tax increase reflected in the budget. The City Secretary is hereby directed to place on said Budget and to sign an endorsement reading as follows: "The Original Budget of the City of Uvalde, Texas, for the fiscal year 2014-2015", and to keep such Budget on file in his/her office as a public record.

Section 3. By vote taken separately from the vote adopting the budget, the City Council hereby confirms, ratifies, and approves the property tax increase reflected in the budget.

Section 4. In support of said Budget and by virtue of the adoption thereof, there are hereby appropriated out of available cash funds and out of the general and special revenues of the City which will be received in the treasury during the fiscal year 2014-2015 the amount set forth in said approved Budget for the various purposes stated herein.
