

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING FENLEY STREET AS ONE WAY TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS; AMENDING CHAPTER 10.28 ONE-WAY STREETS, OF TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE UVALDE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 10.28.070 IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADDING ONE-WAY STREET DESIGNATED-FENLEY STREET; AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.030(C), 10.28.060(C), AND 10.28.090(C) OF THE UVALDE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REQUIRE CERTAIN ROADWAY RESTRICTIONS DURING THE HOURS POSTED; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY CLAUSES; PROVIDING OPEN MEETINGS, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

Whereas, the City of Uvalde, Texas (herein the “City”), has the authority to adopt regulations restricting and regulating the direction and flow of traffic on streets located within the city limit; and

Whereas, the City of Uvalde desires to adopt regulations restricting the flow of traffic for Fenley Street to one way traffic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amending of Chapter 10.28 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances. Chapter 10.28 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended by amending Section 10.28.070 (formerly Repealed) to read as follows:

SECTION 10.28.070 ONE-WAY STREET DESIGNATED - FENLEY STREET

- A. There being a public necessity and for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Uvalde, Texas, and for the City of Uvalde, Texas, Fenley Street is designated as a One Way Traffic Street between Getty Street and High Street, in the City of Uvalde, Texas.
- B. The One Way Traffic will flow and travel from east to west starting at the intersection of Getty Street traveling east to High Street as posted.
- C. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle or vehicle on the identified portion of Fenley Street which has been designated as a One-Way Traffic Street, in any direction other than as above stated and as posted.

D. Anyone violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to punishment as provided in Section 1.12.010 of this Code.

Section 3. Amending of Chapter 10.28 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances. Chapter 10.28 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended by amending Sections 10.28.030(C), 10.28.060(C) and 10.28.090(C) to read as follows:

10.28.030 One-way street designated—Portion of Mueller Street.

(C) The one-way traffic travel on Mueller Street, as stated in subsection B of this section, will be in effect as posted.

10.28.060 One-way street designated—Portion of Zaragoza Street.

(C) The one-way traffic travel on Zaragoza Street, as stated in subsection B of this section, will be in effect as posted.

10.28.090 One-way street designated—Portion of Schwartz Street.

(C) The one-way traffic travel on Schwartz Street, as stated in subsection B of this section, will be in effect as posted.

Section 4. Enforcement. The Chief of Police and members of the Police Department, both regular and reserve officers, are empowered to enforce this Ordinance.

Section 5. Penalties. Any person convicted of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred dollars (\$200.00).

Section 6. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications hereof which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 8. Open Meetings. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council and publication as required by the Local Government Code.
