

ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 33

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.32, STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, OF TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE UVALDE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTION 10.32.050 IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND AMENDING SECTIONS 10.32.230(B), 10.32.240(B), AND 10.32.250(B) OF THE UVALDE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REQUIRE CERTAIN PARKING AND LOADING OR UNLOADING RESTRICTIONS DURING THE HOURS POSTED; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY CLAUSES; PROVIDING OPEN MEETINGS, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

Whereas, the City of Uvalde, Texas (herein the “City”), has the authority to adopt regulations restricting the parking of vehicles and the loading and/or unloading of persons or property on streets located within the city limit;

Whereas, the City is authorized to enforce state law, Chapter 681 of the Texas Transportation Code which details privileged parking regulations for disabled persons and the punishment for vehicles in violation of those regulations; and

Whereas, the City desires to adopt regulations restricting the parking of vehicles and the loading and/or unloading of persons or property from vehicles along portions of East Leona Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amending of Chapter 10.32 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances. Chapter 10.32 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended by repealing Section 10.32.050 in its entirety to read as follows:

10.32.050 (RESERVED)

Section 3. Amending of Chapter 10.32 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances. Chapter 10.32 of the Uvalde Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended by amending Sections 10.32.230(B), 10.32.240(B) and 10.32.250(B) to read as follows:

10.32.230 No parking zone — Portion of East Leona Street.

(B) Designation of No Parking Zone. The City of Uvalde, Texas hereby designates and establishes a no parking zone on the south side of East Leona Road in the City of Uvalde, Texas from the intersection of East Leona Road and Fourth

Street to the intersection of East Leona Road and Fifth Street, in the City of Uvalde, Texas. The no parking zone shall be marked by signs showing designated no parking hours.

10.32.240 No parking zone — Portion of East Leona Road, with the exception of loading or unloading.

(B) Designation of No Parking Zone. The City of Uvalde, Texas hereby designates and establishes a no parking zone, with the exception that permits loading and /or unloading of a person and/or persons, on the north side of East Leona Road in the City of Uvalde, Texas from the intersection of East Leona Road and Fourth Street to the intersection of East Leona Road and Fifth Street, in the City of Uvalde, Texas. The no parking zone shall be marked by signs showing designated no parking hours.

10.32.250 No loading or unloading zone—Portion of East Leona Road.

(B) Designation of No Loading or Unloading Zone. The City of Uvalde, Texas hereby designates and establishes a no loading or unloading zone on the south side of East Leona Road in the City of Uvalde, Texas from the intersection of East Leona Road and Fourth Street to the intersection of East Leona Road and Fifth Street, in the City of Uvalde, Texas. The no loading or unloading zone shall be marked by signs showing designated no loading or unloading hours.

Section 4. Enforcement. The Chief of Police and members of the Police Department, both regular and reserve officers, are empowered to enforce this Ordinance.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications hereof which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 7. Open Meetings. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council and publication as required by the Local Government Code.
