

ORDINANCE 2016-03

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, REPEALING
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2004-03 PROVIDING FOR FLEA MARKETS AND
PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Uvalde, Texas, (the "City") determines that Ordinance Number 2004-03 providing for flea markets is no longer necessary and wishes to repeal said ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. **Findings of Fact.** The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. **Repealing Ordinance.** Ordinance Number 2004-03 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval by the City Council.

Section 4. **Open Meetings.** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act *Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code.*
