

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 – 2018 THAT WILL REQUIRE RAISING MORE REVENUE FROM PROPERTY TAXES THAN PREVIOUS YEARS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, following the public notice duly posted and published as required by law, a public hearing was held, by and before the City Council of the City of Uvalde; the subject of which was the proposed budget for the City of Uvalde for Fiscal Year 2017-2018; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.007 (c) of the Texas Local Government Code requires a separate vote on a budget that will require raising more revenue from property taxes than the previous year shall be ratified by a separate vote from the adoption of the budget or tax rate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby ratify the adoption of a budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 which will raise more revenue from property taxes than the previous year.

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after passage, as the law provides.

On the following motion by Councilman Chip King:

“I move to ratify the property tax revenue increase shown in the 2017-2018 budget”; seconded by Councilman Stephen Balke, the above foregoing property tax revenue increase shown in the 2017-2018 budget was passed and approved by roll call as follows:
