

ORDINANCE 2019-04

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 12.36 OF THE UVALDE MUNICIPAL CODE, GRAND OPERA HOUSE; SETTING A FEE FOR THE USE OF THE OPERA HOUSE ANNEX AND DESIGNATING THE HOURS DURING WHICH THE FACILITY MAY BE RENTED AND RELATED MATTERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Uvalde has the authority to set fees and rules for use of the Uvalde Grand Opera House, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires fees and rules to promote fair use of the Opera House for all individuals and groups, while providing for a modest return to the city and ensure proper use and maintenance of the facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1.** That existing Chapter 12.36.050 – License Fees of the Uvalde Municipal Code, existing paragraphs D and E are amended to read as follows:

D. Any additional hours will be charged at \$30.00 an hour. But no more than two individual hours per day will be granted. Anything exceeding two hours will count toward a full eight-hour day and will be charged accordingly.

E. The fee to rent the opera house annex for one day is \$250.

**Section 2.** That existing Chapter 12.36.070 – Use regulations, existing paragraph B is amended to read as follow:

“B. A licensee may not use the facility for any purpose between the hours of 11:00P.M. and 8:00A.M. on a licensed date”.

**Section 2. Conflicting Ordinances.** All prior ordinances of the city are hereby amended to the extent of any conflict herewith. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency between this ordinance and any other code or ordinance of the city, the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.


**Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the city council and following publication of the caption or summary, as provided by the City Charter or the Texas Local Government Code.
