

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS DEDICATING 3.83 ACRES OF PARKLAND ALONG THE LEONA RIVER IN THE KIWANIS PARK SPORTS COMPLEX TRIAL SYSTEM AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT (A) ATTACHED, AS OPEN SPACE FOR PERPETUITY, AS REQUIRED BY THE TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT; APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION BY THE CITY MANAGER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Uvalde City Council desires to provide quality park facilities for the residents of City of Uvalde; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Uvalde has obtained a grant from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for the development of a community park and desires to comply with all of the requirements set forth in the grant.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS THAT;**

**SECTION 1.** In order to fulfill the requirements of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's grant to the City of Uvalde, the City Council of Uvalde, Texas hereby designates 3.83 acres of parkland along the Leona River in the Kiwanis Park Sports Complex trial system for Open Space.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor of the City of Uvalde, along with the City Manager, are hereby authorized to execute the appropriate documents approving the terms and conditions of the agreement with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.


**SECTION 3.** Any prior Resolution of the city Council in conflict with the provisions contained in the Resolution are hereby repealed and revoked. This resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution 2012-09.

**SECTION 4.** Should any part of this Resolution be held to be invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby declared to be severable.


**SECTION 5.** Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is so duly resolved.

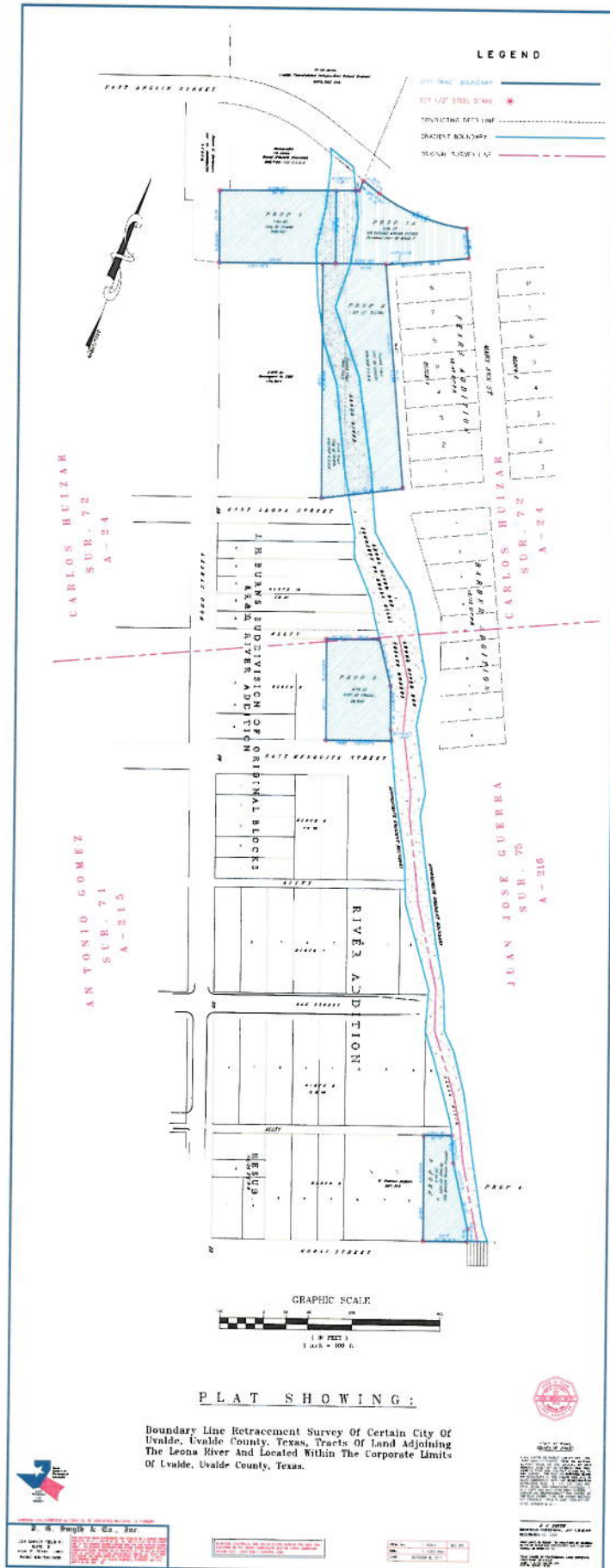
