

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-09

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES AND CLERKS  
TO SERVE AT THE CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD  
ON SATURDAY, MAY 10, 2014.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Uvalde adopted Resolution number 2014-02 calling for a City Election to be held in the City of Uvalde on Saturday, May 10, 2014 and

**WHEREAS**, the laws of the State of Texas require that a Presiding Election Judge, Alternate Presiding Election Judge, and Early Voting Ballot Board Presiding Judge be appointed for the above stated election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Uvalde, Texas, that:

**SECTION 1.** In District 1, Ms. Yvette Hernandez of 2727 E. Main Street, will serve as Presiding Judge. Ms. Rosalinda Mirelez will serve as the alternate judge. Clerks for the election will be appointed by the Presiding Judge at a number not to exceed 2 clerks.

**SECTION 2.** In District 2, Ms. Jean Brannum of 1222 North Park will serve as Presiding Judge. Mr. John Hogan will serve as the alternate judge. Clerks for the election will be appointed by the Presiding Judge at a number not to exceed 2 clerks.

**SECTION 3.** In District 3, Mr. Albert Mireles, 218 W Calera, will serve as Presiding Judge. Ms. Grace Rodrigues will serve as the alternate judge. Clerks for the election will be appointed by the Presiding Judge at the number not to exceed 2 clerks.

**SECTION 4.** In District 4, Mrs. Blanca Velasquez, 800 Ft. Clark, will serve as Presiding Judge. Ms. Shirley Grigg will serve as alternate judge. Clerks for the election will be appointed by the Presiding Judge at the number not to exceed 2 clerks.

**SECTION 5.** In District 5, Ms. Sandra Moerbe of 531 Ham Lane, will serve as Presiding Judge. Ms. Zoila Zamora will serve as alternate judge. Clerks for the election will be appointed by the Presiding Judge at the number not to exceed 2 clerks.

**SECTION 6.** Early voting by personal appearance and by mail shall be by paper ballots and shall be canvassed by an Early Voting Ballot Board. Mr. Sergio Porras, 402 S. High Street, shall serve as Presiding Judge. Robert H. Theisen will serve as the alternate judge. The Presiding Judge may appoint up to three (3) clerks inclusive of one alternate judge. He is hereby appointed the Early Voting Ballot Board for said election.


**SECTION 7.** A copy of this Resolution shall be given to the Presiding Election Judges and Alternate Presiding Judges, and shall serve as the notice of appointment required to be given by Section 32.009 of the Texas Election Code.
