**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE,  
TEXAS, FIXING COMPENSATION FOR ELECTION JUDGES AND  
CLERKS SERVING FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD  
MAY 10, 2014.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS:**


**SECTION 1.** Each election judge and clerk appointed by the City Council to serve, and who actually serves, in the municipal election to be held on May 10, 2014 will be compensated from the general fund of the city at the rate of \$9.00 per hour actually served. A judge or clerk will not be compensated for more than one hour of work before the polls open.

**SECTION 2.** The election judge or clerk who delivers election records, keys to ballot boxes or other election equipment, and unused election supplies after the election will be compensated from the general fund of the city in the amount of \$25.00 for that service.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized and directed to pay the compensation provided in the Resolution to the persons thereto entitled, in due course after receipt of a statement of compensation in the form prescribed by Section 32.094 in the Texas Election Code.
