

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 17

A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF UVALDE CONCERNING THE MUNICIPAL POOL AND PROHIBITION AND PROTECTION OF SUCH MUNICIPAL POOL SITE FROM ANY SURFACE DRILLING AND MINING ON THE SUCH SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Uvalde ("City") is participating in a Local Park Grant Program with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department; and

WHEREAS, funding received from the Local Park Grant Program will be used directly to repair and renovate the Municipal Pool; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the grant application expressly states that the applicant must provide evidence that the surface of the project site is protected from any drilling or mining; and

WHEREAS, the project site is the Municipal Pool is located at 301 E. Nopal Street, is owned and under the direction and control of the City; and

WHEREAS, the project site is located within a FEMA designated flood plain; and


WHEREAS, all such surface drilling and/or mining is prohibited in such location

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Uvalde, Texas as follows:

1. Findings. The above-referenced clauses are hereby adopted within this Resolution;
2. Warrant as to Drilling. In consideration of terms and conditions contained in the Local Park Grant Program with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department, the City hereby warrants that any surface drilling and/or mining on the said project site of the Municipal Pool located at 301 E. Nopal Street, Uvalde, Texas is prohibited.


