

RESOLUTION LBSP FY-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM FY 2016 (LBSP-16) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Uvalde desires to apply to the Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) of the Governor's Office for a Local Border Security Program Grant Application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered and supports the Application to ensure the safety and security of citizens living in the City of Uvalde, Texas and within the border area; and

WHEREAS, City of Uvalde agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Local Border Security Program FY 2016 funds, the City of Uvalde assures that the funds will be returned to the Homeland Security Grant Division;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UVALDE, TEXAS:

1. That a Local Border Security Program FY- 2016 Grant Application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of City of Uvalde with the Homeland Security Grant Division.
2. That the application be for \$ 75,000.00 of grant funds for overtime and operational mileage for enhanced patrol and investigated capacity for the Uvalde Police Department from October 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016.
3. That the City Council directs, and designates the Uvalde City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Local Border Security Program FY 2016.
